

Competences to be acquired

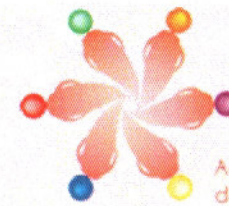
- Reflect on teaching practice in contexts enriched with ICT;

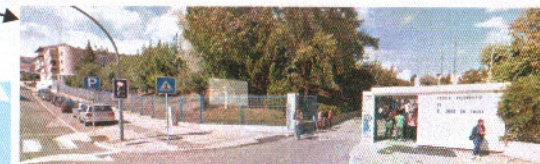
